Online registration cutoff May 21, 2020 - 8 am central time. \$10 late fee for race day entries. Entry fee includes \$4.75 rider insurance and \$1 IBRA surcharge. Payout places limited to 50% of riders for each event

Friday Night Fever Criterium is a 14 block, .865 mile loop course that starts on Jefferson St. between 5th and 6th St. and heads west to North 8th St., where you will climb a total of 39 feet at a 6.7% grade to Washington St., head east on this straight flat road toward Main St., turn south and then quickly turn west back on to Jefferson St. completing the loop. With a total ascent of 52 feet, this fast and fairly flat twilight criterium is a new and exciting addition to Snake Alley in 2020!

Race Rules:

Registration is from 2:30 pm at the Steamboat Senior Center - 501 Jefferson Street - Downtown Burlington. You must pick up your numbers before the close of registration for your event. Registration closes 1 hour before the scheduled start time for each event. If you fail to pick up your number on time, you may forfeit your entry fee and your number will be offered to riders on any waiting lists. You will not be allowed to race if you do not have your racing license. You are required to show your license to registration officials before you are given your number.

Riders will be staged in order of registration.

NO FREE LAP at Friday Night Fever Criterium

You must wear an approved helmet and have it properly fastened at all times you are on a bicycle at a race. This includes while warming up, on or off the course.

Photo finish at all criteriums for the weekend.

Your racing license must be presented to collect any prizes. Prizes may be paid by check, you maybe required to sign a receipt. Prizes of \$600 or more are reported to the Internal Revenue Service for which Social Security Numbers will be requested.

NO REFUNDS, in accordance with USAC rules. All USAC rules to apply.

Course is located at Jefferson and Fifth Streets in Burlington, Iowa. Take US Highway 34 downtown. From the west, take the "last Iowa exit". From the east take the first Iowa exit. Take Main Street south to Washington Street, then turn east and park on the riverfront. Absolutely no warming up on the course before 4pm.
